



HOLBROOK HEIGHTS POOL RULES

Lifeguards and the pool manager will enforce the pool rules, and will remove individuals at their discretion. Violation of the pool rules may result in immediate removal from the pool area, and/or loss of pool privileges. Refunds will not be given to those who lose pool privileges for rules violations.

Please take time to review the discipline policy for the community pool.

1. All swimmers must shower with soap before entering the pool.
2. All swimmers must wear appropriate attire. This is a family pool so no skimpy or revealing attire will be allowed. Stringy cutoffs are prohibited. Shoulder length or longer hair must be tied back.
3. The "kiddie pool" is for use for children 6 and under, directly supervised by an adult. As posted, there is no lifeguard at the children's pool.
4. All diaper age children must wear swimmer diapers.
5. No glass containers in the pool area.
6. Children 12 and under must be accompanied into pool area by an adult or guardian over 18. There must be a ratio of one adult for every three children age 12 and under.
7. During family swim period, all children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18.
8. Clear the pool immediately when the lifeguards blow their whistles.
9. Do not distract or interfere with the lifeguards.
10. The pool will be cleared for children's mandatory 15-minute breaks each hour during General Swim and Family Swim at: 45. An example: 5:45pm, break until 6:00pm. Adults can stay in the pool during breaks.

HOLBROOK HEIGHTS POOL RULES (CONTINUED)

11. No running in the pool area.
12. No diving in the shallow end.
13. No diving off the diving board when it is closed by the lifeguards.
14. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time. No diving off the diving board if swimmers are in the deep end.
15. No playing, swinging, jumping or diving from the ladder. No swimming over, hanging on to or playing with the lifeline.
16. No pushing, throwing, tagging, dunking, "chicken fighting", or splash fighting with other swimmers.
17. Only competent swimmers* as determined by the lifeguards are allowed in the deep end. *swimmers must complete one length of the pool swimming freestyle without stopping.
18. No profanity, inappropriate or offensive behavior. No loud or disruptive music.
19. No skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, or similar equipment in the pool area.
20. No alcoholic beverages or controlled substances in the pool or park area.
21. No smoking, chewing tobacco or gum allowed in the pool or park area.
22. No soiling or defacing of the pool or park area.
23. Persons with infectious or communicable diseases, open sores, wounds, or who are bleeding may not swim or otherwise enter the pool.
24. In the event of inclement weather, the pool may be closed without prior notice at the discretion of management.
25. Use of flotation devices, noodles, beach and nerf balls may be limited at the discretion of lifeguards.
26. All lifeguards reserve the right to remove anyone from the pool area who does not comply with the pool rules and regulations.
27. Access to pool building or equipment areas is limited to authorized personnel. Do not tamper with or adjust pool equipment.
