

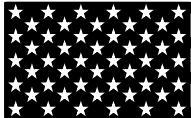
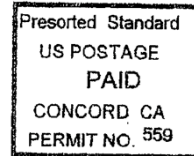

H O L B R O O K H E I G H T S P O O L R U L E S

In the event of inclement weather, the pool may be closed without prior notice at the discretion of the management. Holbrook Pool and Park are considered a Smoke & Drug Free environment.

All individuals/families must fill out the pool registration card at or before their first visit to the pool. Only people listed on the card will be allowed to use the pool. There will be no substitutions of people listed. Please sign in each time you use the pool. Guests must be signed up and accompanied by a homeowner who is 18 or older and there is a limit of 4 guests per residence per day.

General pool regulations:

- All swimmers must shower before entering the pool
- Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult and the ratio cannot exceed 1 adult to 3 children.
- For the enjoyment and safety of others the following will not be tolerated: alcoholic beverages or any controlled substance, glass containers, skateboards, (continued on other side)

HOLBROOK HEIGHTS POOL RULES (continued)

rollerblades, bicycles or other related equipment, running, pushing or rough-housing in the deck area, loud music, profanity or inappropriate behavior, smoking, chewing tobacco or gum.

- No one is allowed to remain near the ladder areas.
- Do not dive into the shallow end or the pool.
- Clear the pool immediately when the lifeguards blow the whistle.

Pool attire

- All diaper- age children must wear swimmer diapers.
- All swimmers must have correct swim attire, no street clothes.
- Hair must be tied back.

Kiddie Pool

This is for the use of children, age 6 and under, and with direct supervision of an adult (over 18). There is NO lifeguard assigned there. Swim diapers must be worn if the child is not toilet trained.

Safety Regulations in the general pool:

The lifeguards are there for your safety. They should not be distracted in any way from their job. Please limit your contact to immediate in-pool problems. Other concerns may be taken up with the pool manager or check-in person.

For the safety of all members no pushing, throwing, tagging, dunking, "chicken fighting" or splash fighting with other swimmers is allowed. People with open wounds or who are bleeding will not be allowed to use the pool.

Only members who have demonstrated competent swimming ability (one lap of the pool free-style, without stopping) will be allowed in the deep end or diving area. The test will be given by the lifeguards.

Diving area

When opened by the lifeguards, straight dives only off the board no cannonballs or flips. Dive one person at a time when the diving area is clear. No playing or jumping off the ladder or hanging onto the lifeline.

Swim Times

- The mandatory 15 minute breaks for swimmers under 18 will be at the last quarter hour during General and Family swim (example 2:45 – 3:00 PM)
- Family Swim all children under 18 must be accompanied by someone over 18. Ratio 1 to 3 children.
- Adult Swim – NO LIFEGUARD AVAILABLE- only those 18 or older are allowed in the pool or pool area.

DISCIPLINE POLICY: All lifeguards have the right to remove anyone from the pool area who doesn't comply with the pool rules and regulations.

Across from 2507 Meadowbrook Drive
3207 Baker Drive
2116 Athene Drive

Attendants will monitor dumpsters, which will be restricted to residents who show a copy of this coupon/newsletter.

Dumping will begin at 8:00 a.m. and continue until 12 noon or when the boxes are full, whichever is earliest. Commercial dumping is not allowed.

PLEASE BRING THIS COUPON / NEWSLETTER WITH YOU WHEN YOU BRING YOUR MATERIALS TO THE DUMPSTERS

Concord Disposal Services will not allow the following items to be placed in the dumpsters: Hazardous materials, paint, motor oil, car batteries, tires, refrigerators & other appliances.

Furniture and large items must be broken up. It is recommended that you recycle all items that have potential for future use and help to preserve the environment.

Paint and hazardous materials can be disposed of at: Contra Costa Hazardous Waste Collection Center, Imhoff Place – Martinez (Adjacent to the Waste Water Treatment Plant)

- First offense is a 15-minute time out.
- Second offense, the person will be asked to leave for the day and the parents will be notified.
- Continued offenses might result in the person being asked to leave for the remainder of the year.
